Role Overview

We are seeking a committed and experienced Assistant Counselling Tutor to support the delivery of counselling training across an academic year. This role involves working collaboratively within a team of tutors to facilitate student development, assess practical skills, and contribute to the academic progress of learners. The position combines both onsite and online teaching, primarily delivered on Saturday afternoons/evenings, with occasional sessions scheduled on Friday evenings or Sunday mornings where required.

Key Responsibilities

- > Facilitate skills practice sessions, providing constructive feedback to support student development (CBT labs and psychodynamic presentations)
- > Observation and feedback for student formative presentations on their clinical practice.
- > Undertake academic marking for up to 5 students across the academic year
- > Work collaboratively with Senior Lecturers, fellow tutors, and external supervisors to support student learning and wellbeing
- > Contribute to maintaining high standards of teaching, learning, and professional practice

Teaching Commitment

- > Delivery across 8 teaching blocks per academic year, consisting of:
 - > 6 onsite blocks at Waverley Abbey College
 - > 2 online blocks
- > Sessions typically delivered on Saturday afternoons/evenings, with occasional alternative scheduling

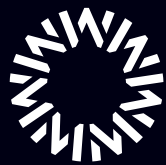
